Wearing masks indoors is mandated once again. While in Church, please wear a mask, social distance, and stay home if you have a cough or fever.



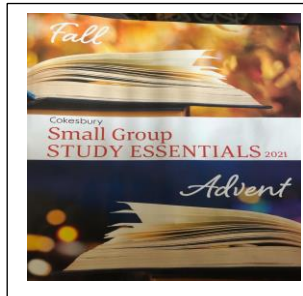
