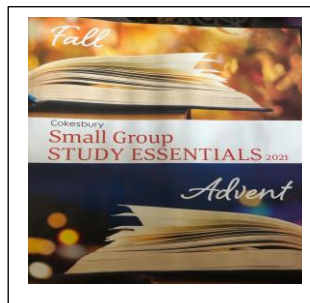
Coffee Time with Pastor Sandi

First Mile Mission

Below is a list of programs:**

Native American Ministries nurtures missions with Native Americans and provides scholarships for United Methodist Native American seminarians.

Peace With Justice enables The UMC to have a voice in advocating for peace and justice through a broad spectrum of global programs.

World Communion provides scholarships for U.S. racial- and ethnic-minority students and international students, on both undergraduate and graduate levels.

United Methodist Student Day furnishes scholarships and loans for students attending UM-related and other accredited colleges and universities.

Human Relations Day strengthens UM outreach to communities in the United States and Puerto Rico, encouraging social justice and work with at-risk youth.

UMCOR makes the love of Christ real in the lives of those who suffer the effects of disasters in the US and 99 other countries.

Rural Life recognizes those who do hard and holy work of getting healthy food into our homes. This is a way to remember to be thankful for the food we eat and those that grow it.

Gibson City Flooding Collection

We collected \$1310. for Gibson City to help those in need of housing.

Although we are done with collecting for Gibson City, you may always give to the Conference Disaster Response Assistance Fund. This IGRC Fund is a Conference Advance Special Fund which aims to provide a caring Christian presence in the aftermath of a natural or human-caused disaster.
